

Over time, the use of well water causes subsidence in the land in our community. Continued subsidence can contribute to flooding during heavy rains. In order to reduce the area's dependency on well water, the West Harris County Regional Water Authority (WHCRWA) was created to begin construction of water lines for the supply of surface water.

The WHCRWA charges the District a fee per 1,000 gallons of water produced at the District's two wells to help pay for this conversion. This fee is passed along to District customers as a separate line item on your water bill. Effective with your January 13, 2009 water bill, this fee will increase to \$1.09 per 1,000 gallons of water used by each customer.
